Car Park 2 Picnics

Owners and trainers' picnics in Car Park Two are an important part of the fabric of Royal Ascot. We are extremely proud that the whole racing community from around the world congregates there before and after racing and want to do everything we can to protect this tradition. In order for us to do this, however, we do need to seek everyone's co-operation in maintaining these picnics as just that. In recent years, the level of activity in the Car Park has expanded to include cooking equipment, professional caterers (including waiting staff), branded marquees (including with stable names) and DJs. This has changed the nature of the Car Park and made parking difficult for many people, especially those arriving close to racing who are there with runners/rides and need to park quickly. We are kindly and politely asking this year that these concerns are borne in mind in everyone's interests and to save embarrassment on the day as activity will be monitored.

Owners Badges 2025

After the success of our new owners' badges last year, we will continue with personalised badges, designed with horse's name and owner's individual silk colours.

Named badges will no longer be available.

Owners' badges are the equivalent to Queen Anne Enclosure, and also allowing access to the Owner and Trainers' bars & facilities.

Allocation

Owners are offered the following badges:

- A sole owner with a runner will be offered up to six owner badges (with lunch), and the ability to purchase up to an additional four daily owner badges.
- Partnerships/syndicates with a runner are offered two options:



Syndicates

We offer for syndicates to swap their complimentary lunches for up to 10 owner badges. Additional Owner star badges are available to purchase (up to 20 badges in total, complimentary and to purchase).

Syndicates that are members of the RSA will automatically be able to book their badges on the dedicated online booking system. Other syndicates will need to confirm their wish to do this ahead of booking badges. If you think you may have a runner at Royal Ascot, we encourage you to email us in advance.

Parade Ring passes

We offer 6 parade ring passes per runner per race.

Badge Application

Please note that the PASS System will not be in use for Royal Ascot.

Applications for badges, lunches and Parade Ring passes will open after declarations for each Royal Ascot raceday (10am, 48 hours before).

Royal Ascot Owners and Trainers Online Booking

The listed owner or first named in a partnership or syndicate will be sent further digital communications following entries and declarations in June, including the link for badge application.

Dress Code

All owners and trainers must adhere with the Queen Anne Enclosure Dress Code as a compulsory minimum. <u>Queen Anne Enclosure Dress Code</u>. Those with Royal Enclosure badges will need to adhere to the Royal Enclosure Dress Code. <u>Royal Enclosure Dress Code</u>.

Car Parking

Owners' car parking is situated in Car Park 2 and is allocated one car park label and one space for each horse running. Owners with a declared runner will be emailed a digital car park pass which must be shown to access Car Park 2 on the day of your runner.

Additional purchased parking, is available in Car Park 8 or 6 on the day. Car Park 6 is available for <u>pre-booking here</u>.
